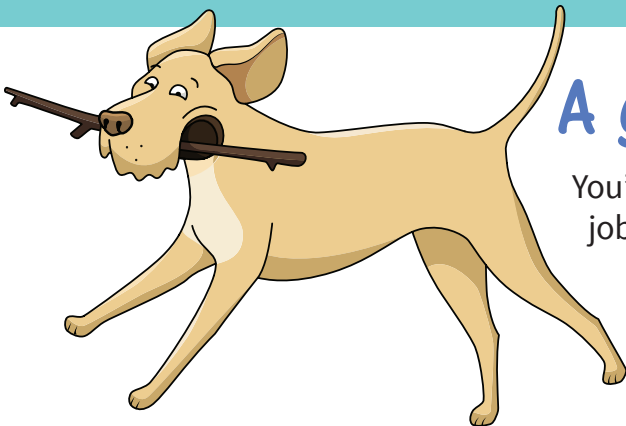


WALKING DOGGOS

2-7 players

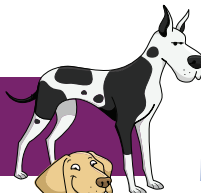

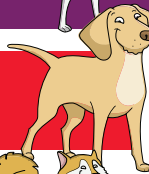
A game of being barely adequate

GAMEPLAY

Walking Doggos is a trick-taking game with blind hands. The goal is to take fewer tricks than your opponents. There are six suits of dogs of various sizes. Each suit has eight numbered cards in it. Larger numbers beat smaller numbers, but larger dogs beat smaller dogs.

Players take turns giving and receiving hints about the cards in their hand, then bet on the number of tricks they believe they'll win. Bet low and work too much and you'll only tire yourself out. But bet too high and you might get fired if you can't make your quota! Get exactly as many tricks as you bet to win the game.
