

WHAT YOU WILL NEED

- 6 Candles
- A Lighter
- 1 six sided die

Before you begin, decide why you will never be able to see each other anymore.

Is it because of distance? Circumstance? Irreconcilable differences? Make it tragic. Make it sad. Draw from your real life. Make it hurt.

HOW TO PLAY

Dim the lights. Place the candles between the both of you and light them. Take turns to roll the die.

If your number is below the number of candles lit, tell each other something you loved about each other or you are grateful for. Light a candle if there is any to light.

If your number is equal to above the number of candles lit, tell each other a secret - something you have never told them before. Blow out one candle.

Use the table to the right to determine what it is you have to say. Cross out each one you used. Don't think too much about it beforehand - just say it.

After saying what you need to say, ask your partner how they feel or might react. Talk about it.

Play until the both of you have rolled 7 times each.

SECRETS

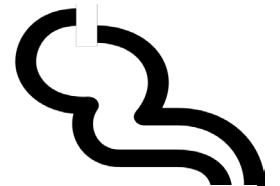
- You betrayed your bond in a vulgar way. What was it?
- You broke their trust behind their back. How did you stop them from finding out?
- You lied to them. What was the lie about?
- You said something bad about them behind their back.
- You never told them that they once hurt you. Badly.
- You had never felt so alone but you never told them.
- They lied to you. You knew but didn't say anything.
- They didn't meet your expectations and you were disappointed.
- You took out your anger on them but they never knew why.

HOW TO END

If there are **4-5** candles left burning, you end it on a good note. Both of you can move forward, unburdened.

If there are **3** candles left burning, decide if you want to let it end on a good or bad note. Your feelings are mixed and complicated.

If there are **0-2** candles left burning, the relationship poorly. Describe how you walk away from each other for good.
