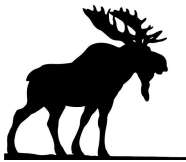
Running the Game: This is a GMless game that requires a six-sided die. You can play solo or with friends. Tell a story of your quest for fame and fill your recognition track with positives before it fills with negatives.

When you roll the dice, you affect the recognition track. A success improves your recognition by 1, while a failure adds a negative 1. Once a track is completely full, the game ends. Narrate the ending based on your recognition. Are you the new Bigfoot, or do a few New Englanders think they may have heard something about you once?

On a 4 or less, you fail! Something bad happens. Tell us what happened and mark 1 negative recognition.

Opportunity:

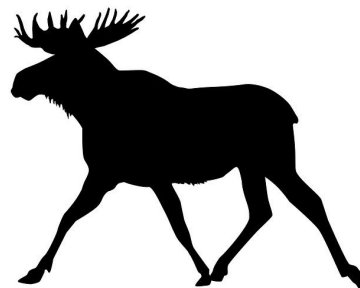
- 1) A scout troop on a camping trip!
