uncertainties

Where are your family and
friends? Did they stay in that
place you left or did they leave
before you did? Did they have
the same reasons as you to
flee?

to go through. What are these
about? What are your fears?

loneliness

You have experienced a period
of deep loneliness. Were you
totally alone or did you belong
to a group but still feeling
alone?

How did you experience this
loneliness? What did you think
about during this period?

hardships

You were involved in an escape
without a possible return.

Where are you now? What have
you lived through since you
left? What did you see that will
leave an indelible mark on you
forever?

What sacrifices did you make?

Errance (roaming in french) :

The act of walking, of travel-
ling without interruption.

– The act of walking without
purpose, at random.

– Can also refer to the action
of “*tergiverser*” (French word
for delaying a decision or a
commitment; word that may
have a political connotation).
