Two players will sit down and face off, armed with nothing more than their chess pieces, a few scraps of paper, and an extremely limited knowledge of chess. Using a very basic set of game rules and mechanics, these players will engage in what *looks like* an intense chess battle between two masters of the game.

It is dramatic.

It is silly.

It might be a real game, but it’s definitely fake chess.

VARIATIONS

(Fake Chess is flexible. Feel free to fool around.)

Want to focus on PERFORMANCE & ROLE-PLAY?

Normally, one player action (in the “If You” column) leads to one fancy chess move (in the “You May” column).

Change that ratio.

Before the game begins, agree that players must make two (or three) actions before getting to take advantage of a fancy chess move.

(Players are still limited to one action per turn.)

Want to focus on CREATIVE TACTICS?

Normally, players have access to seven fancy chess moves that can help them win.

Reduce that number.

Before the game begins, agree that players must eliminate three (or four) fancy chess moves from their game sheets.

Want to get EXTRA COMPETITIVE?

Normally, players can select any game from their book.

Eliminate that choice.

Agree that both players must use the same game.

Want to keep things LOOSE & CASUAL?

Normally, players cross off actions they use.

Instead, agree to not cross off character actions, allowing players to reuse their favorites throughout the course of the game.

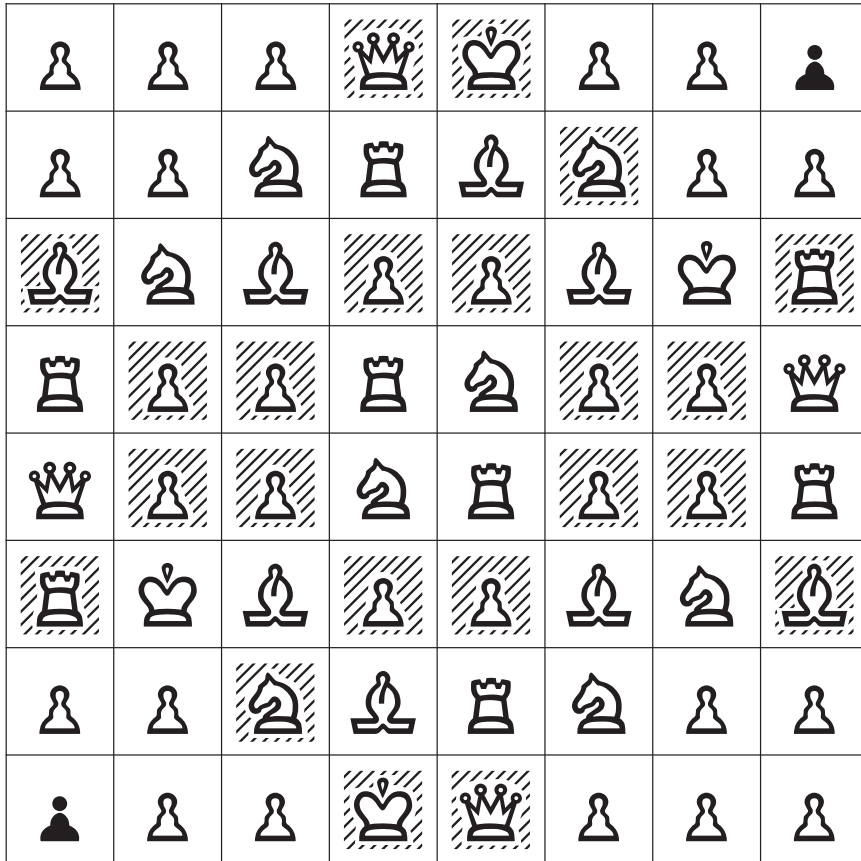

W A A T I S F A C E C A E S S ?

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MATERIALS

REQUIRED:

- One chess set
- Two players
- Two writing instruments
- Two Fake Chess books (or pages torn from a single book)

RECOMMENDED:

- One chess clock
- Six spectators, three seated on each side of the chess board, ready to provide dramatic reactions and erudite commentary



SET UP

Place all the chess pieces on the chess board.

Each player opens their books and selects a game.

White moves first. Players alternate turns.

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GAME X

CHECKMATE

BEGIN

PLAY

YOUR FIRST TURN

Get in character.

Mark the square labeled “Begin.”

Move one of your pawns. (The first square is always a pawn.)

SUBSEQUENT TURNS

Mark a new square. It must share an edge with a previously marked square.

Move the piece you marked.

You may not mark a square if you do not have the piece to move.

MOVING & CAPTURING

When you mark an unshaded square, you move the piece to ANY empty spot on the board.

When you mark a shaded square, you use the piece to capture an opponent’s piece.

The final piece you capture must be a pawn. You can never capture the king.

SPECIAL MOVES

Fake Chess players gain advantages by acting like real chess players.

Each game uses a standard list of player actions. Any action (in the “If You” column) can get any result (in the “You May” column).

When you do something, cross it off the list.

WINNING & LOSING

































































If you capture all of your opponent’s pieces (except the King, of course), you win.

If you mark the square labeled “Checkmate,” you win. Announce your checkmate and claim your victory.

If you are unable to mark a square (because you do not have the pieces you’d need to move), you lose. Resign the game.

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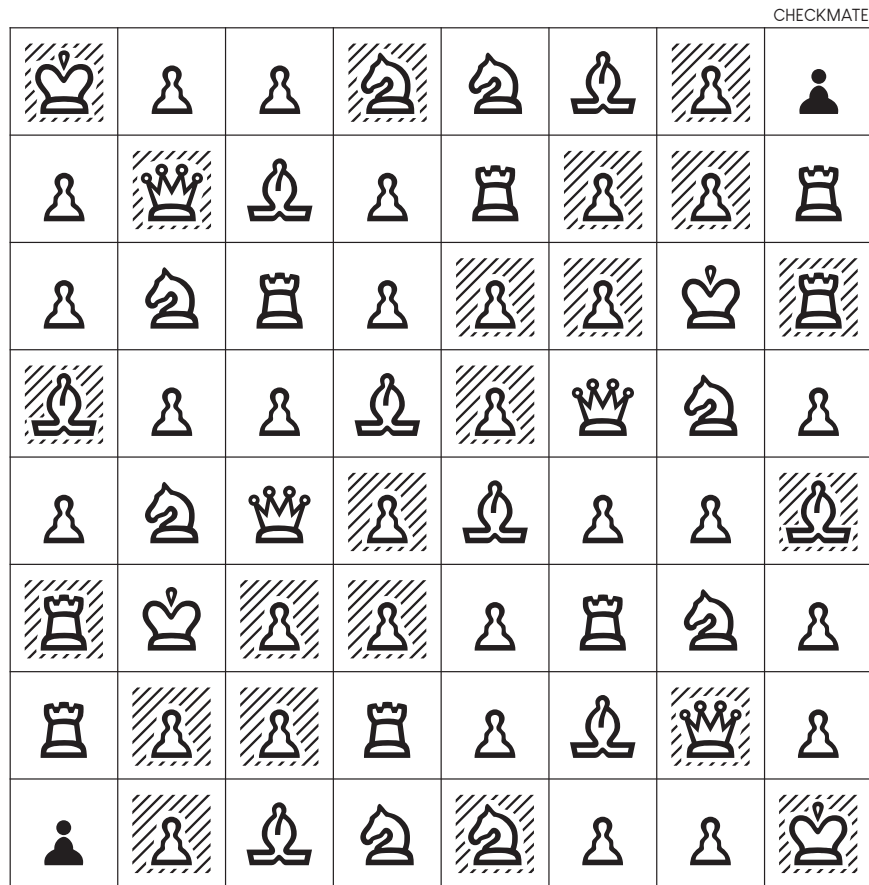
