Creating the Festival

The Festival of Deep Winter brings people together for warmth and connection. Tell us about the Festival. Take turns answering these questions and exploring other thoughts that grow from them. Write the answers on an index card for each element.

Food and Drink

What do we eat and drink at the Festival? Why? What role does food and drink play in the celebration?

Example: Sharing a meal as togetherness -- Food inspired by fables

Ritual

What rituals are performed at the Festival? Are these rituals formal or informal? Are these done in private or in public? Is it secular or sacred?

Example: Opening gifts -- Attending a religious ceremony

Gathering

Who comes together? Do people meet in large or small groups? Where do people meet?

Example: Holiday concerts -- Visiting friends or family at someone's home

The Town

How does the town change for the Festival? What do you see and hear? Who is in charge of the transformation?

Examples: Ice sculptures in the market -- hearing holiday music in shopping centres

Preparation

How do we prepare for the Festival? How long does it usually take? How stressful is it?

Examples: Decorating the house -- Cleaning the house

Aesthetics

What are the symbols of the Festival? What are the Festival colours? Flavours? Scents?

Red and green -- Candles

Exploring The Festival
