Kitty Cat



Pet

Reduce all enemy Attack rolls by 1

This fluffy, fluffy kitty cuddles your enemy, reducing their ability to harm you ever so slightly.

Deal 2 Damage to all your foes! Then discard this card.

This chaotic computer-generated caprinae tears through your enemies like a wrecking ball on cocaine. Then it speeds off on a bicycle, defying all reason.

Internet Rainbow Cat



Pet

Decreases your foe's next Evasion roll by 2

You unleash this pastry-clad, rainbow-propelled space cat upon your foe, baffling them with its constant, repetitive cries. Now would be an excellent time to hit them.

Felix the Flying Fox



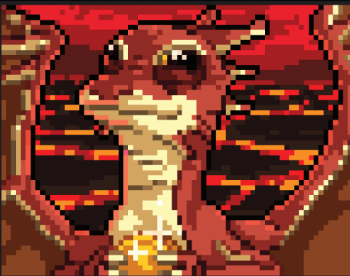
Pet

Steal one Item on the Battlefield before discarding this card

After graduating first in his class at the Fox College for Foxes, Felix the Flying Fox (self-titled) immediately built an Arduino-powered Glidey-Go™ for the sole purpose of swooping out of the sky to steal really shiny things for his den.

Dragon



Pet

At the start of your turn, and on playing this card, deal 1 Damage to all enemies.

Far from imposing, this baby fire lizard makes up for its size by spitting teeny-tiny fireballs at each foe at the start of your turn.

Explody Toad



Pet

Roll 1d6. Odds, you fumble the frog and suffer 2 Damage. Evens, the frog lands in the center of the battlefield and frightens away all other pets. Discard this card.

The exploding toads of the Sargasso Swamps are good for one thing: Chucking them at your foes and hoping you don't get hit with frog guts.

Demon



Pet

The Demon devours and then replaces your foe's pet.*

You're sick and tired of this *thing* staying up all night and eating all your food and/or pets. Time to push it on to someone else.

*The Demon does not act as your pet. You play him directly from your hand.
